## A message from Mrs Farren...

Easter is a wonderful time of year. The days are longer, the air warmer and growth and new life are all around us. Team Norton hopes that you make the most of this time with your children. Put down those screens, turn off your devices and appreciate the beauty that is spring. Go for fun learning walks, listen to the birds (see if you can tell which kind of bird it is that you can hear), count how many different types of new shoots and flowers you can spot. Why not draw them and bring your creations into school after the Easter break; we would love to see them!

**Reception** class have had a very creative week! We have learnt about how and why Christians celebrate Easter and this linked beautifully to our work on 'signs of Spring'. We have had lots of fun making handprint chicks, Easter headbands and colouring Easter pictures. We have had a brilliant half term and we are very proud of the progress that the children have made. We are looking forward to the Summer term!

**Year 1** have been looking at the Easter story in our RE lessons this term, and particularly focusing this week on why we celebrate Easter. On Tuesday we had a whole Easter 'craft-ernoon' where we watched the Easter story, and then got crafty creating Easter crowns—which we will be wearing on Friday for Easter potato rolling! We've also created wonderful Easter cards and hanging pictures, it's been a lovely creative week!

In **Year 2** we have been learning about Easter and why it is important to Christians. We have looked at signs of spring/new life as well as making Easter headbands. In computing we have edited photos and identified photos which are real and fake.

This week in **Year 3** we have been using the Easter Story to create interactive crosses to share the story of Jesus. We have also been developing our understanding of fractions by comparing fractions with different denominators (When the numerators are the same, the smaller the denominator the greater the part) and then with different numerators (When the denominators are the same, the greater the numerator the greater the fraction). We hope you have a wonderful Easter break.



**Year 4** enjoyed a morning with Reverend Joe with the theme 'my world, our world, the whole world' and took part in different activities including a prayer wall. The children really loved it. In English, we have finished our leaflets about persuading people to visit the Amazon Rainforest, we included rhetorical questions and persuasive language. In maths, we have been continuing our learning with decimals, looking at tenths and hundredths in a place value column and then using this knowledge to divide 1 and 2 digits by 10 and 100.

**Year 6** This week we have looked at how we, as a country, trade with other countries around the world. We were amazed to see how far certain foods travel to get to our plate. We studied the pros and cons of this process, discussing how importing food aids communities around the world. In contrast to this benefit, we discussed how food miles harm the environment due to the increased burning of fossil fuels.


