

Computing – This term we will be looking at networks and how computers are connected and what a digital device is. We will then be looking at branching databases.



English – Children will be looking at their use of setting descriptions in fiction writing this term. In non-fiction we will be learning how to write a persuasive piece of text as well as writing to give a reader information on a topic.

Reading – Please continue to read at home every night. In our guided reading we are working on our comprehension skills. Please ask questions about the texts at home when reading!

Maths – Our focus this term is ‘place value’. The children will be learning about the place value of 3-digit numbers and how to add and subtract them. We will then be extending our knowledge of the times tables to include the 3s, 4s and 8s.

History – This term we will be looking at pre-history. We will look at changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will look into how historians use sources of information in order to inform their ideas about the past.

French – This term we will be looking at phonics in French and how this differs from English. We will learn some simple French greetings, colours and animals.

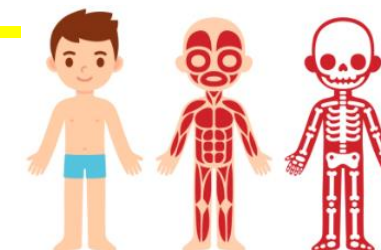


PSHE – This term we will be learning about “me and my relationships” and valuing the differences between different people.

At home you could....

- Listen to your child read regularly.
- Practise comparing and ordering 3-digit numbers.
- Support with spelling with the spelling homework
- Use times table rock stars to improve rapid recall of facts.

Science – This term we will start by looking at the human body. We will learn some common bones and their purposes as well as nutrition in humans and animals. We will then learn about rocks and fossils. We will learn about the formation of fossils, the different kinds of rocks and about the formation of soil.



PE – This term the children will be learning about movement in Gymnastics and playing net and wall games.

Religious Education – This term we will be looking at creation in Christianity and “People of God”.



Art – Complementing our history lessons and children’s understanding of how we know about the past, we will be learning about prehistoric cave paintings. We will learn about the kinds of pigments they used and create our own cave painting.
