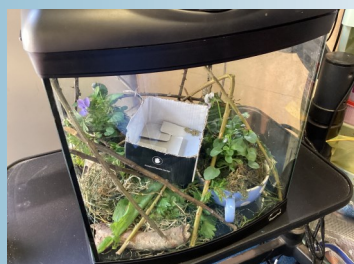

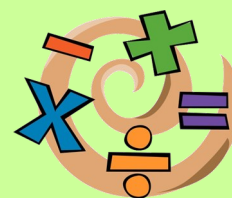
Example:

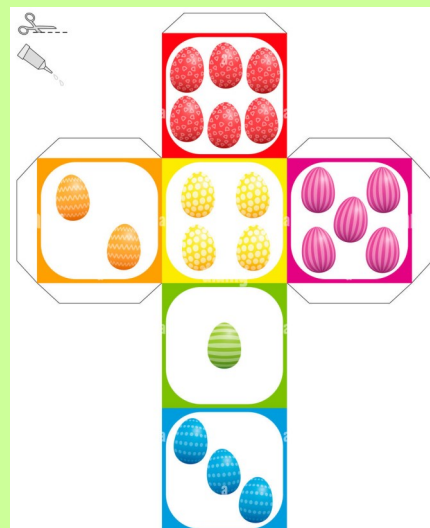
Can you make it fun enough to play with friends or family?

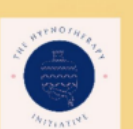
