We are delighted that our Ofsted report is now public. The full report can be found on our website but it begins with: *'Pupils thoroughly enjoy attending Norton Church of England Primary School. They are enthusiastic about their learning because teachers make it fun and meaningful.'*

Pupils show positive learning attitudes towards the varied activities and learning they receive. Leaders and all adults have high expectations. The work the pupils produce is of a good quality. Pupils are proud of their school. They are well aware of the school's vision and how they are able to put this into their everyday lives. Pupils are polite and courteous to each other. Pupils say that everyone is kind and thoughtful, nobody is left out. Leaders have created a culture of respect and care amongst the adults and pupils. Pupils behave well and support each other both in class and at play. Pupils say that there is no bullying in school but would know who to talk to if they had any concerns. Positive relationships are a strong feature of the school. Staff, pupils and parents commented on the 'family' atmosphere of the school. All pupils are welcome. Pupils have many different opportunities to develop themselves both socially and academically. Those pupils who have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) are supported well by adults.'

Because it was only a section 8 inspection, the overall judgement of good could not be changed. However, the report clearly celebrates the school and recognises its unique and excellent qualities. Thank you to our dedicated school governors and staff team for their hard work and skill.
