# A little bit about us....

Norton Little Learns provides a safe, stimulating and fun environment for children from 2 years, 9 months until 4 years old. With a real passion for Early Years, the staff share the same aim of waiting the children to build lots of happy, positive memories whilst building the love of learning. Through a mixture of child initiated and adult planned activities, we ensure the children are well supported to develop and reach their goals.

The stetting provides a smooth transition for those going into the reception class; our reception teacher often joins us for story time, we join in with the whole school assemblies, have older children read to us and we go to Open the Book assemblies. We also join the infants for some activities such as play time and welly Wednesday.

In Little Learners we operate a key person system where each child is allocated a staff member to oversee the journals and assessments. We pride ourselves on the close relationships we build with the families and understand the importance of working together to best support the child's development. Each child has a learning journey; this is shared with parents/carers regularly. Regular assessments are carried out within the setting and reports are shared with parents at parent's evenings three times a year (November, February and June). We will invite you to join us at open days and occasions throughout the year to share what we do.

## Our environment....

This year we will be in the village hall. We have access to a close-by outside space which is connected to the reception class in the main school grounds. We also used the field and M.U.G.A most days, and will be using the new playing park on the field also. We will still use the school playground giving us a strong connection with everyone in the school, helping with transitions if your child was to attend Norton Primary School.

The children love exploring all the toys, and we change the resources we have out often, according to our weekly theme and the children's interests.

#### Activities....

Activities are all play based following the children's interest and planned to incorporate the Early years Foundation Stage Framework. Staff have regular planning meetings and will include the children's ideas and feedback from home.

## Early learning goals....

**Personal Social and Emotional Development:** Making relationships, self-confidence and self-awareness, managing feelings and behavior.

Communication and Language: Listening and attention, understanding and speaking.

Physical Development: Moving and handling, health and self-care.

Mathematics: Numbers, shape, space and measure.

Literacy: Reading and writing

Expressive Art and Design: Exploring and using media and material, being imaginative.

# Characteristics of Effective Learning....

Playing and Exploring: Finding out and exploring, playing with what they know, being willing to 'have a go'.

Active Learning – Motivation: Being involved and concentrating, keep trying and enjoying achieving what they set out to do.

Creating and Thinking Critically- thinking: Having their own ideas, making links and choosing ways to do things.

# Information

#### **Registration and Pricing...**

To register your child's attendance please complete and return the registration form to the school office or email; - <u>admin@norton.gloucs.sch.uk</u>. A letter will be sent confirmation of the hours requested. If you require to change your existing hours, please put your request in writing, giving 2 weeks' notice.

Our sessions run Monday to Friday (term time only) between:

- Morning session: 9am 12pm Monday to Friday
- Afternoon session: 12pm 3pm Monday to Friday
- Full day: 9am 3pm Monday to Friday

Invoices are sent out 6 times a year, within the first couple of weeks of each term.

## Funding – Free for 3& 4 year olds....

Norton Little Learner is registered to take part in the Free for 3&4year old Funding scheme. A parent/carer declaration form will be given out at the beginning of the autumn, spring and summer terms. This is to be completed and returned to school by the required date to ensure funding is received. Failure to return the completed form by the required date may incur charges. Any days outside the funding period will be chargeable. Parents/carers will be notified of the chargeable days and given the opportunity to take their children out of the chargeable sessions; this must be requested in writing.

Funding weeks:

- Autumn term: 14 weeks
- Spring term: 12 weeks
- Summer term: 12 weeks

#### Lunches....

We follow the school's policy on healthy eating and only allow water in their bottles in preschool at all times.

You are welcome send your child in with a packed lunch. Hot dinners are available at a charge of  $\pounds 2.32$ . There is a choice of 3 meals each day. If you would like your child to have a hot dinner please tick off the dinner register when you sign your child in, or phone in the order before 9:15am if your child is in for the afternoon session.

Please send dinner money in a marked envelope on the day. If you would like to pay for the term in advance, we will notify you when your account is running low.

#### Communication...

Little Learners us school Dojo to communicate with parents and for parents/carers to communicate with staff. Dojo is also used to upload pictures of our daily fun. Parent/carers will be sent paperwork to set up an account when their child starts. The Dojo app is free to download.

Teacher2Parents is a texting service used by the school that is used by staff on some occasions.

#### Safeguarding...

Safeguarding is a priority of Norton Little Learners. Please ensure you sign your child in and out on the daily register. Should you be unable to collect our child and you have arranged for someone else to collect them, please inform us when you drop off or call the school office with the person's name who is collecting your child. A password may be required if the person collecting is not known to Little Learners staff.

#### Clothing...

We ask that your children wear practical clothing that may get muddy or covered in paint! Please bring in a spare set of clothing to each session. We spend a lot of time outside and ask that weather appropriate protection is brought in every day (wellington boots, a water proof coat, gloves, hats, sun hats and sun cream). Please also bring in a named water bottle daily.

#### Illness....

If your child is unwell and unable to attend Little Learners, please ring the school office (01452 730531) before 9:30am. Please be considerate when deciding if your child should be brought in if unwell, a good indication they should stay at home is if Calpol is needed. If you are unsure of incubation period of contagious illnesses, such as Chicken pox, please contact us for guidance.

If your child has a stomach bug our policy is that they should be kept off for 48 hours after their last episode.

#### Medicine...

If your child requires medication you are welcome to come in at the required time to administer the medication yourself. If you would like one of the staff to administer medicine to your child, please complete the medicine form (available from the school office). Please hand all medicine to an adult, all medicine is stored in a locked cabinet.

#### Access...

Drop off and collection for Little Learners in the village hall is via the front door. If you arrive late please knock on the front door or the side window as the front door will be kept locked outside drop off and pick up times.

#### Extended Services...

The school runs a before and after school club (chargeable) which can be used by children attending Little Learners. If you wish your child to attend please complete a booking form. See appendix A for more information.

#### GDPR....

We value your right to choose what we do with any personal information that we hold. We will ask you to complete a form at registration that expresses your wishes regarding sharing of photos or information in learning journal, classroom displays or the schools website. For additional GDPR needs throughout the school year, we will ensure you are fully informed and aware.

#### Policies...

# **Terms and Conditions**

## **Before and After School Clubs**

In order that we can provide a safe and well organised club there are a few important points that **MUST** be adhered to:

- You must inform the school of the sessions your child will be attending for the following term by completing a booking form (download from the website or collect from the school office).
- The only exception to this is an emergency booking whereby you **MUST** phone the school on 01452 730531 or email: <u>admin@norton.glouc.sch.uk</u> at your earliest convenience. Please note: We cannot guarantee the after school facility until 5:30pm for emergency bookings.
- If you wish to cancel a pre-booked session, please notify the school by phone or email at your earliest convenience.
- A late fee of £5.25 will be charged for each 15 minutes thereafter. *If you are late* on 3 occasions within a school year, the after school club will no longer be available for your child/ren for the remainder of that year.
- Children attending a school run club will be taken to the After School Club when their club finishes. The whole session cost still applies.
- Registration of children will be similar to that of the school register if your child is unable to attend, we must know as soon as possible as safety is of utmost importance.
- A member of staff will sign your child in and out for before and after school club due to Covid-19.
- The school behaviour expectations and the school policies still apply.

 2yrs 9 months – 11 years old children who are attending Norton Primary School or Norton Little learners.

#### <u>Hours</u>

- Before School 8:00am until 8:45am, Monday to Friday (no breakfast is currently available)
- After School -3:15pm until 5pm, Tuesday and Wednesday, 3:15pm 5:30pm Monday and Thursday (please provide a snack).

#### Charges

- Before School Club -- £1.36 per session
- After School Club until 5pm -- £4.16 per child per session
- After School Club until 5:30pm -- £5.15 per child per session
- Late Fee -- £5.25 per 15 minutes

#### **Invoice**

• Payment is required on receipt of an invoice. Invoices will be sent out at the beginning of each month for the previous month.

We pride ourselves on offering extended services whilst striving to keep our prices low, as this remains a non-profit making service. The charges will be reviewed again October 2021.
