Norton Primary School received £16,100 for disadvantaged children this year

Our aim is to ensure that any disadvantaged children are happy, successful learners. When we plan how to spend this funding, we look at the specific needs of each of these pupils. We focus on any barriers to learning for each child and take action to address these. This year's focus is on emotional resilience.

This report is reviewed with governors in June of each year to ensure that our plans have been successful.
